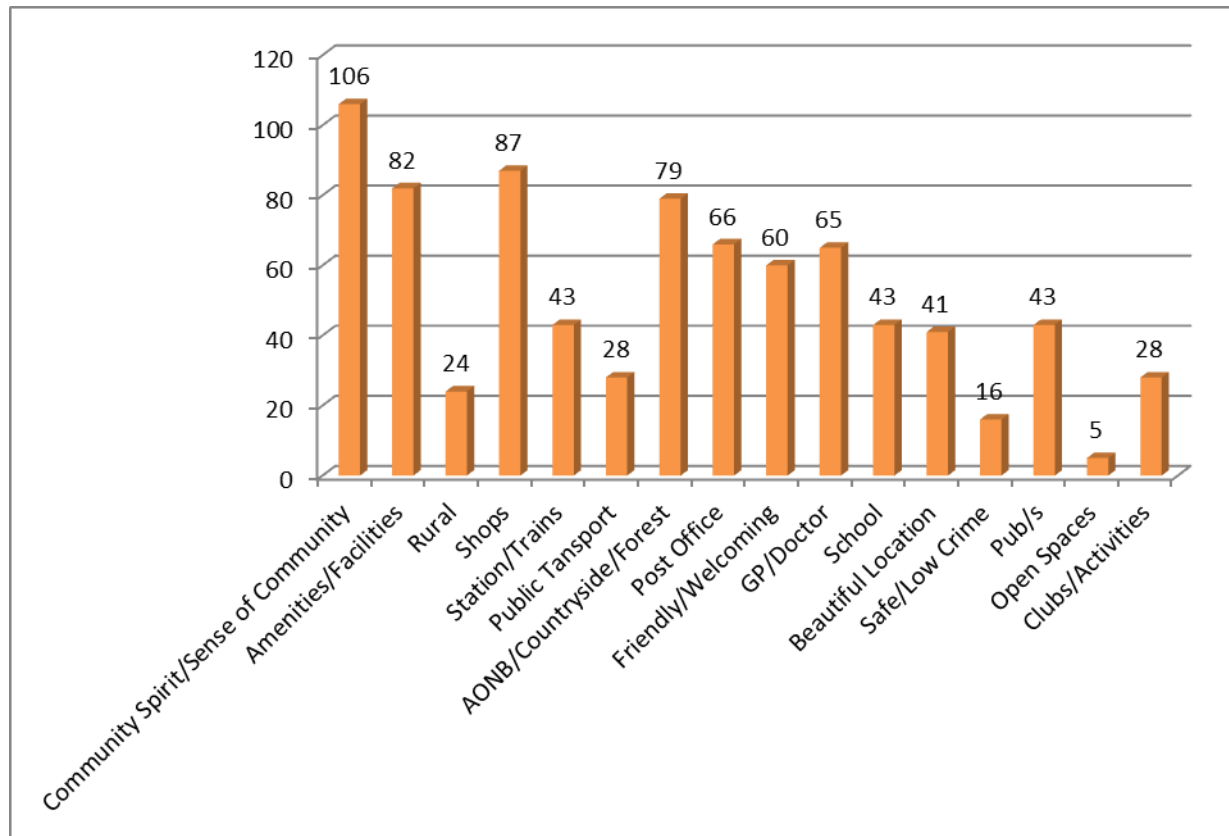

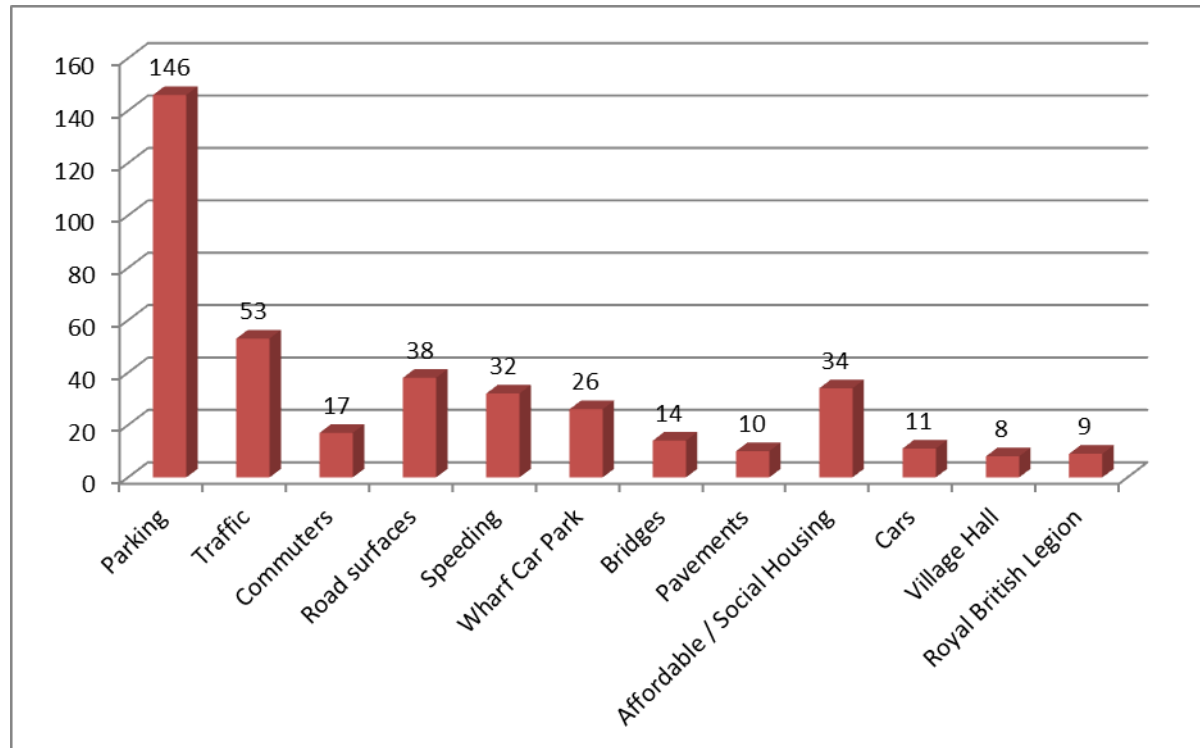

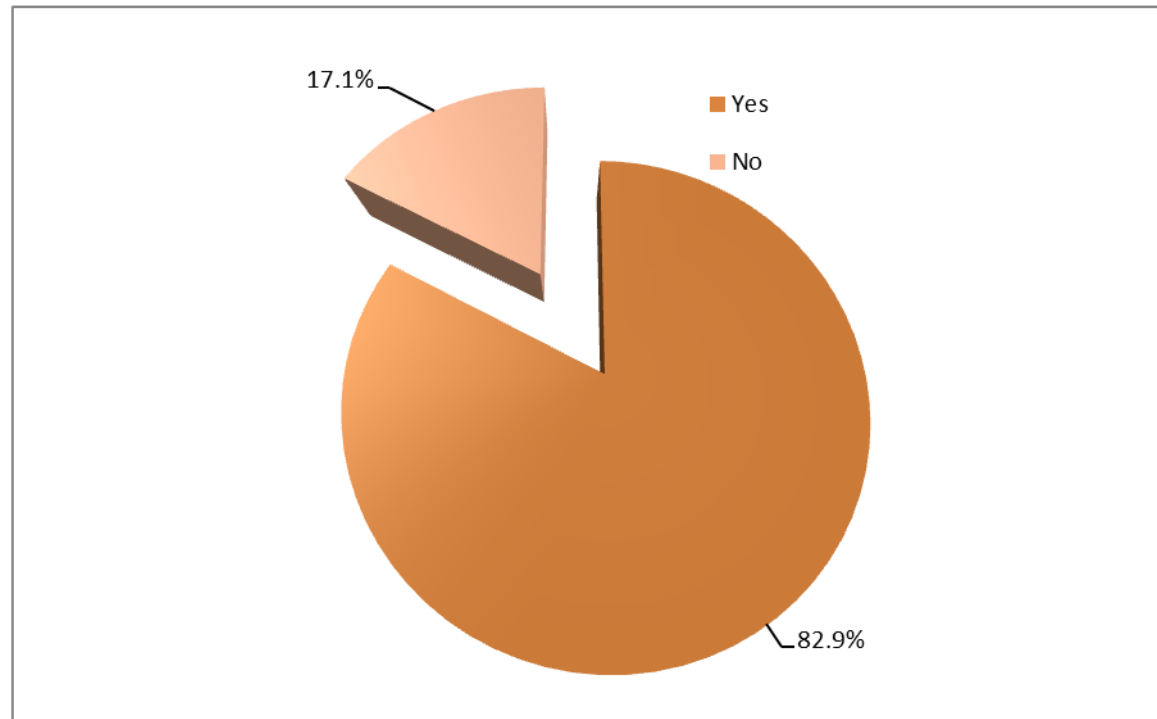

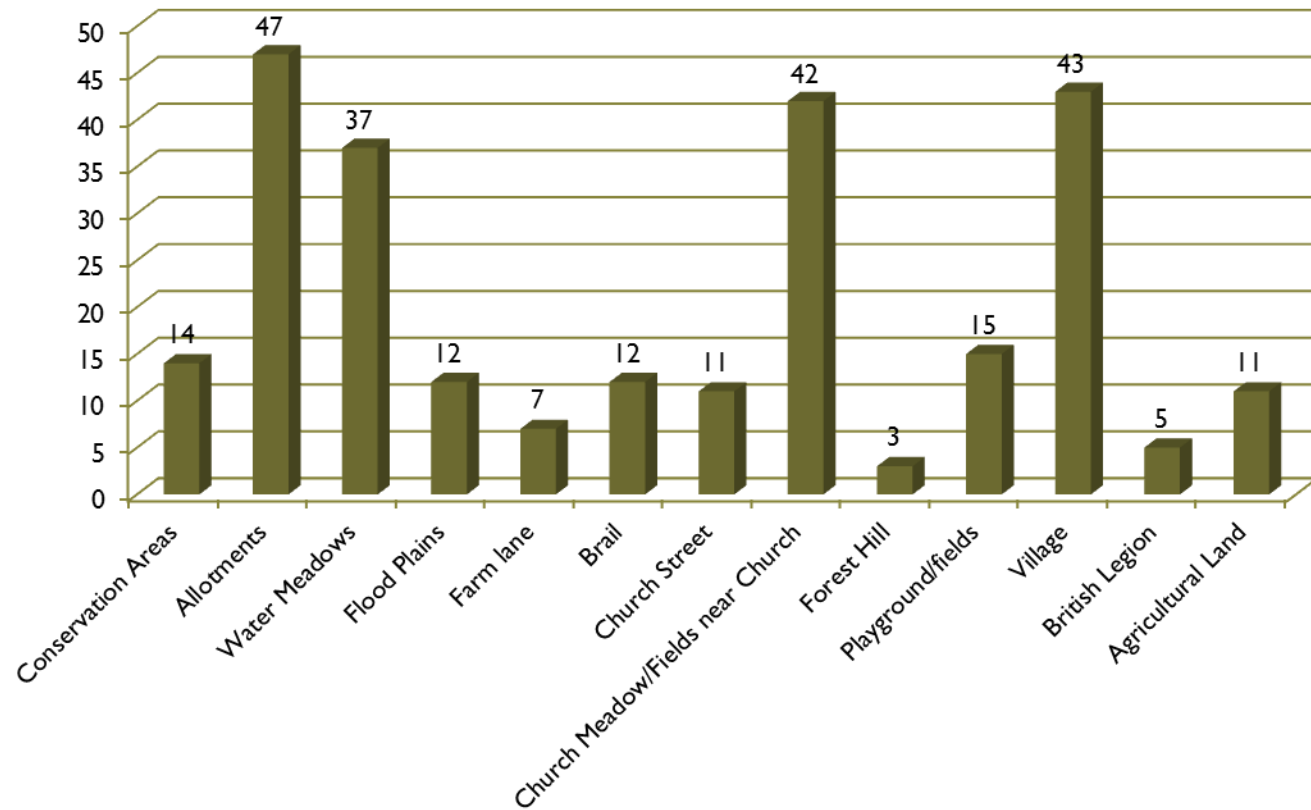

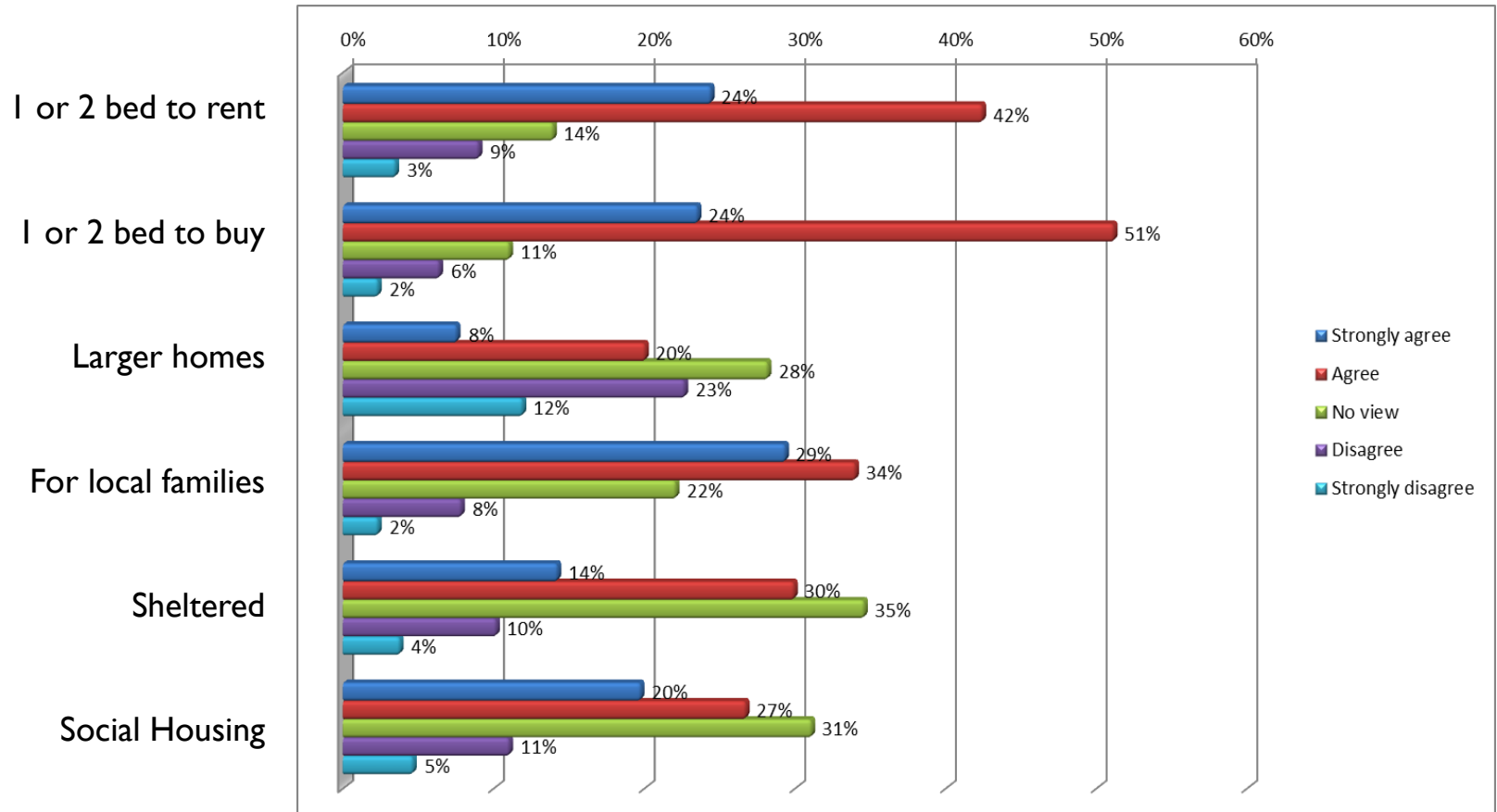

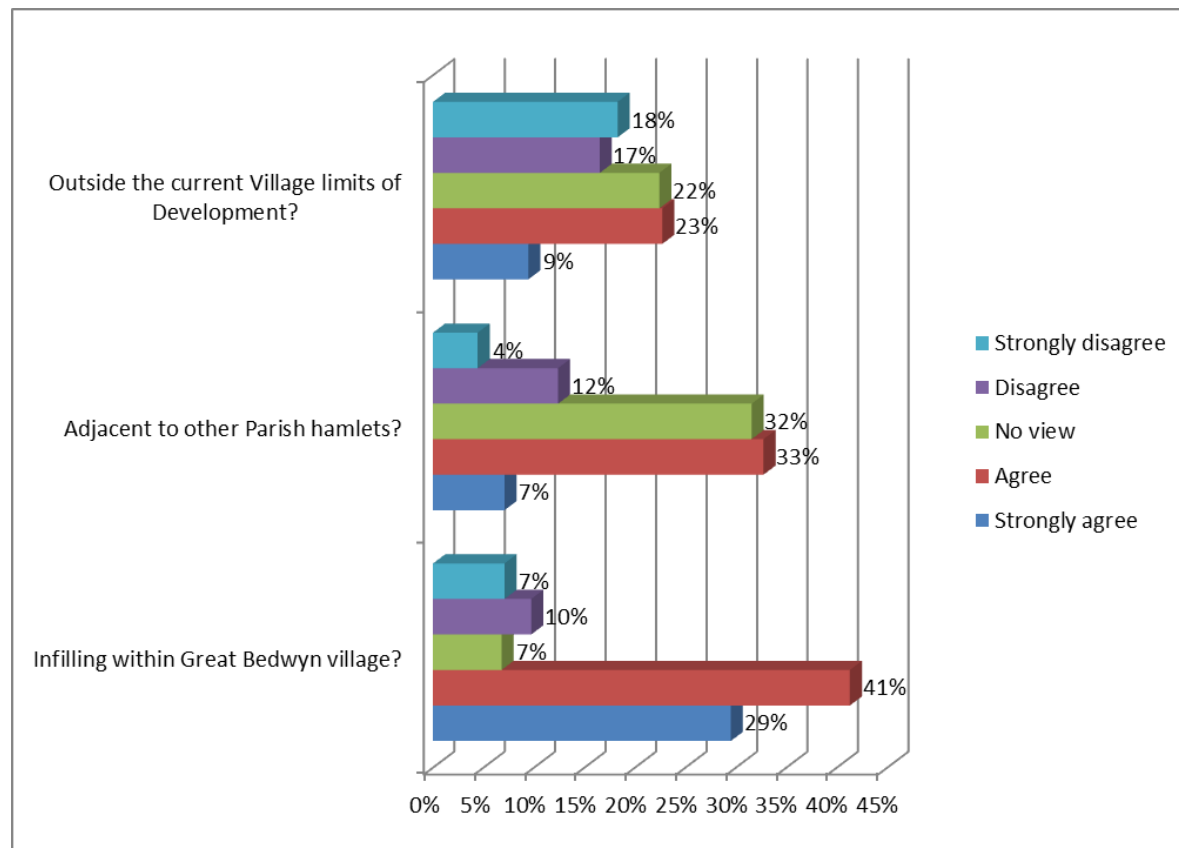

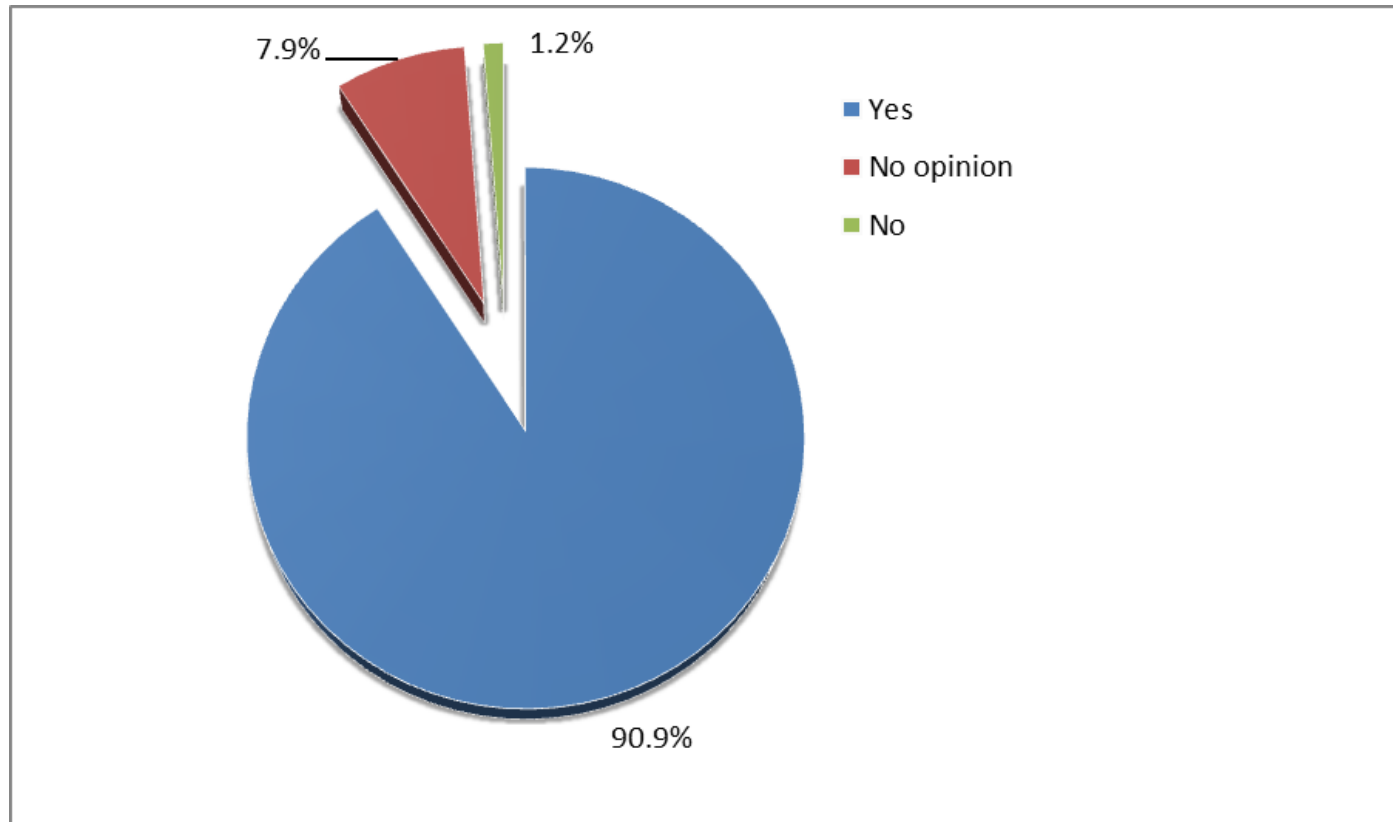

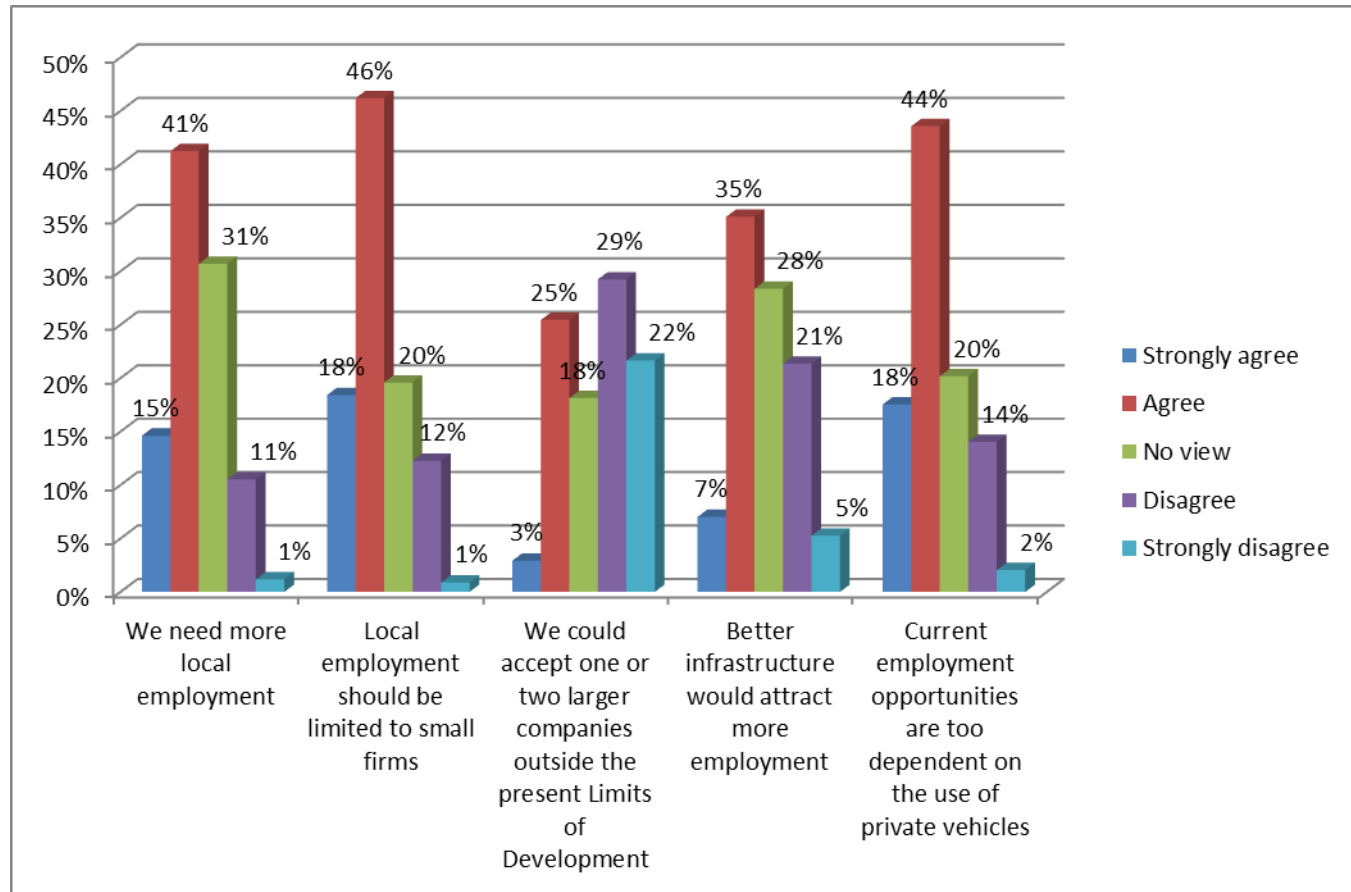

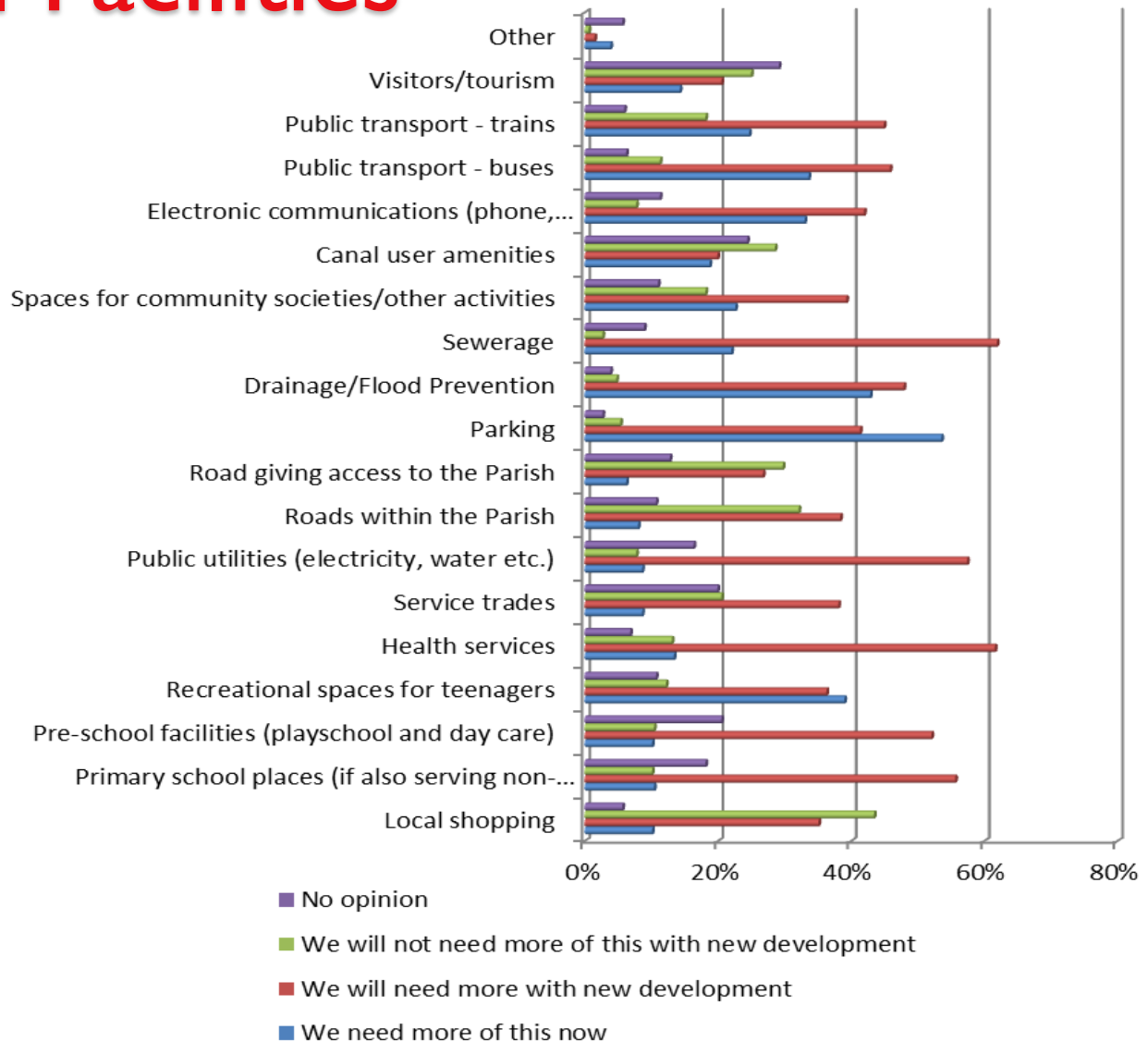

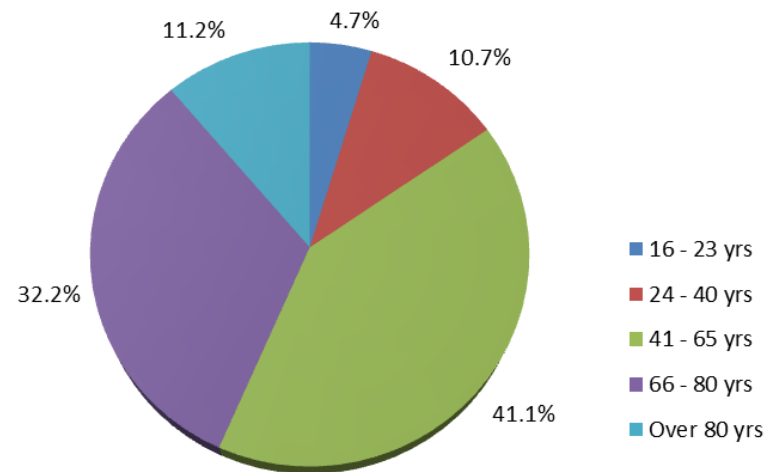

Gender



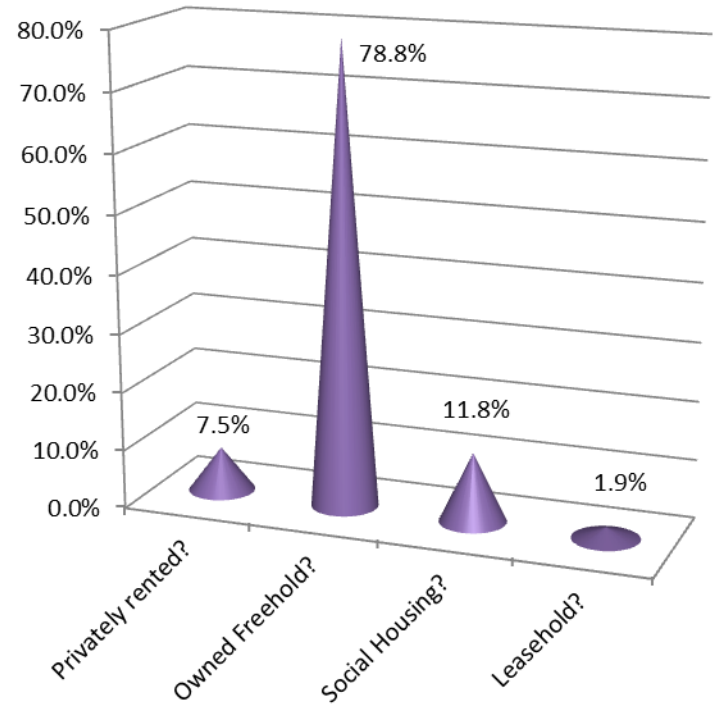
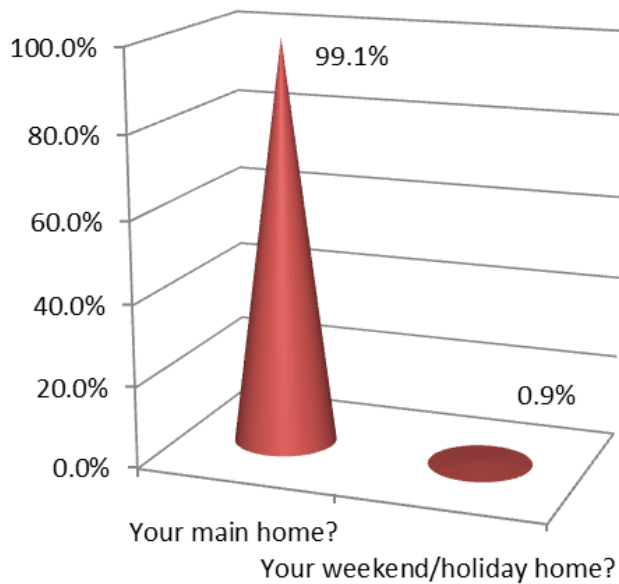

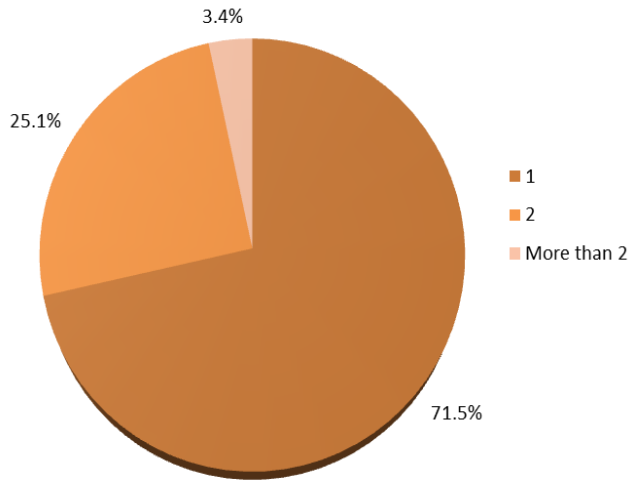
Type of Tenure

Main or Holiday Home?

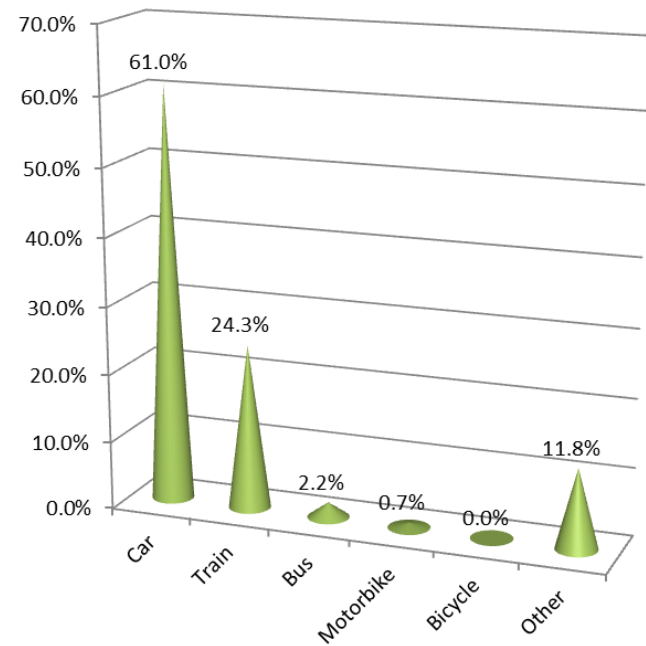

Vehicle ownership



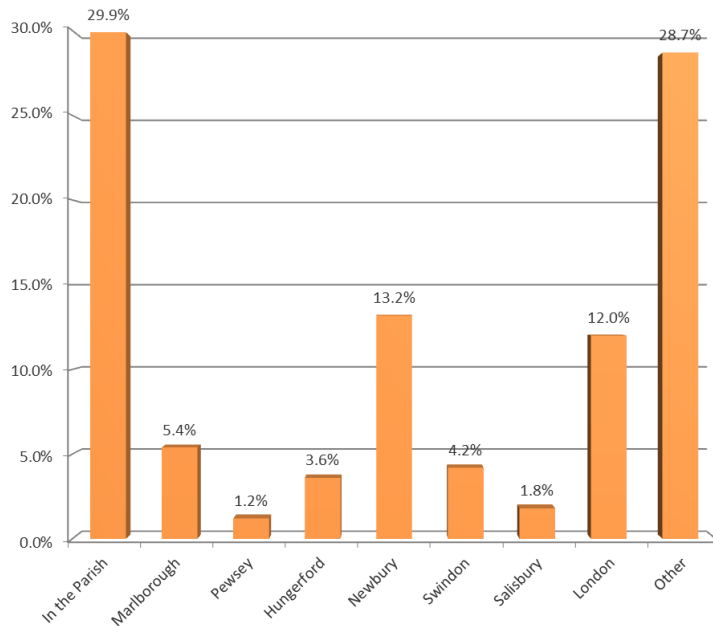
Travelling to work



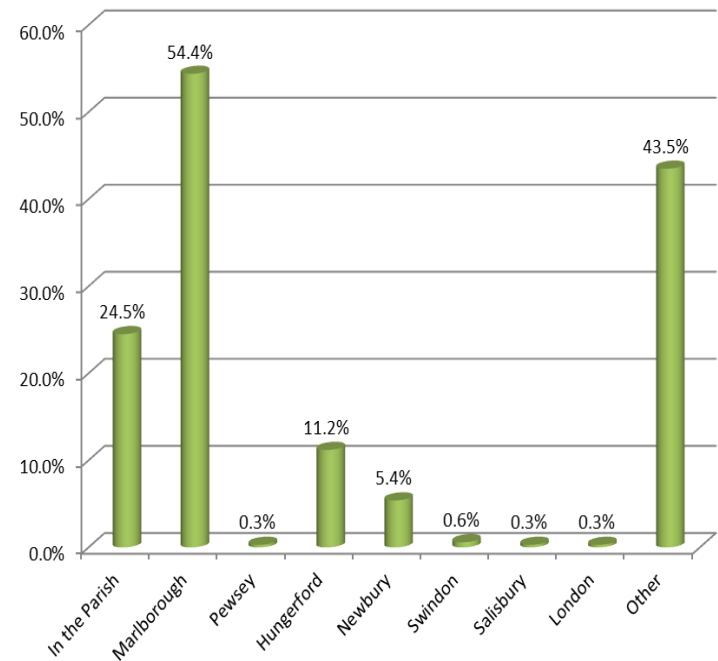
Other methods of travelling to places of employment; combination of means, e.g. bicycle + train, car + train etc.
